## **What to expect...**

When you arrive at the lodge, we ask that everyone help with packing and loading the supplies into the vehicles. When we arrive at the hospital, we will all help unpack and set up. Kristen and Char will organize and guide both of these processes, so that everyone knows what to do and where to go. We set up all the food and drinks in a serving line. After we unpack and set up, there is quite a bit of downtime as the food cooks. Many patients are not able to leave their rooms. Therefore, we have a team who assembles to-go boxes and a team who delivers the meals to the rooms. After the to-go orders are complete, we invite the patients to come and eat. Once all the patients have eaten, we invite the staff to eat and then we eat as well. After that, we pack up and head back to the lodge. Upon arriving at the lodge, we need everyone to help unload and put items back as needed, wash the dirty utensils and put the dirty aprons and towels in the wash, etc.

**There will be quite a bit of standing when serving the food. If needed, you may bring a camp/travel chair, but you will be responsible for transporting it. Otherwise, the site does have picnic tables we can use during the down time.**
