2023 BROTHERHOOD RIDE - CYCLING FOR FALLEN HEROES

October 27, 2023 - November 4, 2023

Our 2023 Ride will be dedicated to 28 Florida Fallen First Responders who died in the line of duty in 2022 while protecting their communities. Our team will honor them as we cycle through the State of Florida for 9-days.

Our team of 50 riders and 25 support personnel will pedal from Naples, FL to Arcadia, Bradenton, Lakeland, Orlando, Cocoa Beach, Stuart-Jensen, Pompano Beach, Hollywood and finish in Miami. We will cover over 600 miles and average 70-90 miles a day.

The Brotherhood Ride is a non-profit charity organization, which consists of Firefighters, Law Enforcement Officers and EMS personnel who ride bicycles to honor emergency first responders who have died in the line of duty. Our mission is to provide emotional and financial support to the families who are left behind.

The Brotherhood Ride continues the tradition of Honor, Dedication and Pride. Over the past fifteen years, we have honored the memory and sacrifice of 707 Emergency First Responders which includes; firefighters, law enforcement officers and emergency medical personnel. Our team has traveled on bicycles over 12,000 miles, through 18 states, have been hosted by over 50 Elks Lodges nationwide and assisted by countless emergency first responders who have shown the true meaning of Brotherhood. Through year-round fundraising efforts, the Brotherhood Ride has been able to honor the memory of fallen heroes and provide emotional and financial support to their families. Past Brotherhood Rides, we have honored our fallen brothers and sisters from SC, TX, NY, FL, TN, GA, VA, PA, NJ, CT and MA and we are very proud to have donated over \$840,000.00 to the families left behind.

The Brotherhood Ride is a non-profit 501(c)(3) public charity organization. Other than the cost of conducting the rides, all donated proceeds go directly to the beneficiaries designated. No one is compensated for their time in order to maximize the impact of donations.
